### Apple Prints

Use the hand-under-hand strategy to help your child make these fall-themed prints.



#### **Supplies:**

- One ripe apple
- Finger paint or Crayola washable paint in a bright color like red
- White paper or cardstock (you can also use black paper for more contrast)

**Directions:**

- Cut the apple in half from the stem.
- Pour or spoon the paint on a plate.
- Help your child hold the apple, using the hand-under-hand strategy.
- Dip the apple half into the paint and press it onto the paper.
- Try making a few more prints. Then let the prints dry.
