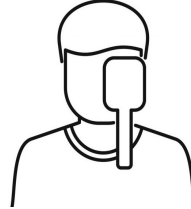
## ABC's of Vision



## Objective Testing



- Appearance of child's eyes and eyelids
- Visual Behaviors (6+ mo.)<sup>1</sup>
- Caregiver's Concerns

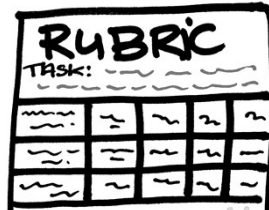


- Corneal light reflex (12+ mo.)
- Photoscreening (12+ mo.)
- Cover test (36+ mo.)
- Visual acuity test (36+ mo.)
